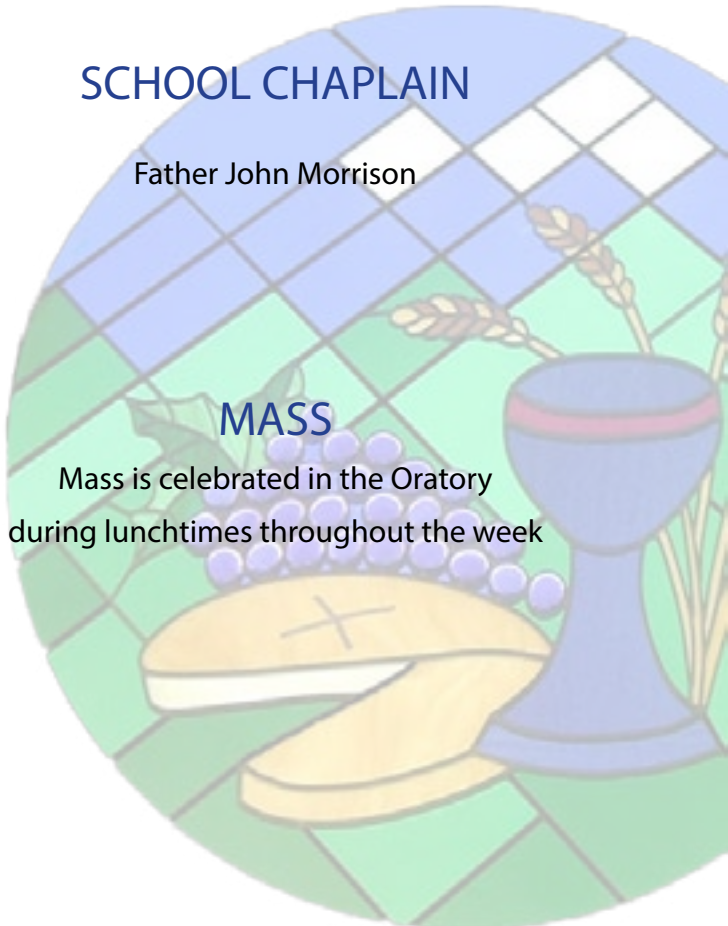

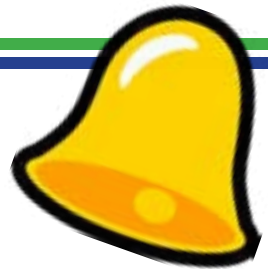

GIRLS

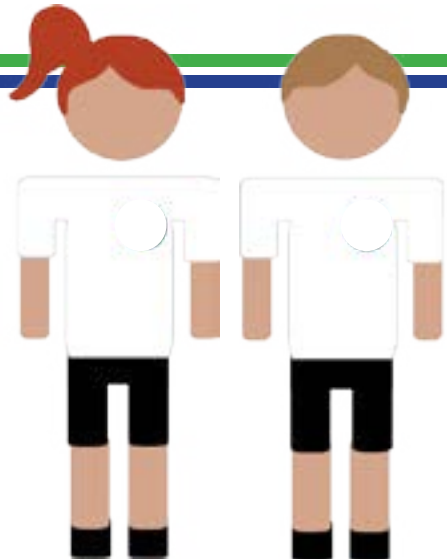
- white shirt
