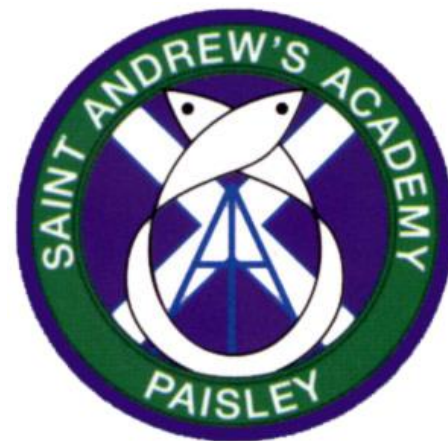
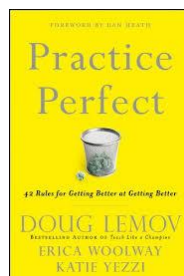

Student Praise Cards were discussed and a suggestion to have a particular focus were made. All teaching staff are reminded that they should issue one per week to a pupil. This is having a positive impact on pupil behavior. We heard back from depts on their change ideas. The full minute can be found [here](#). The Social Subject Dept have found that posting home dept praise cards coupled with the whole dept focusing on praise has resulted in a decline in referrals in a targeted year group.

### DEAR (Drop Everything And Read) Time

This term the English Department have introduced DEAR Time during various days each month. This reading scheme affords S1 pupils time to read for the first 10 minutes after both interval and lunchtime regardless of which subject they are in. This is providing S1 pupils with as much private reading time as possible and compliments our Accelerated Reader initiative.

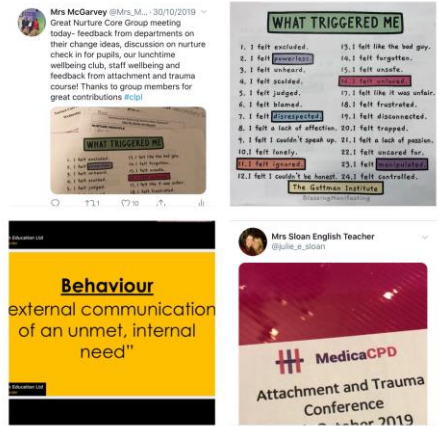


### Learning and Teaching Idea of the Month
