

Digital Learning Ideas

We are all finding new ways to communicate our lessons to pupils on online platforms.

One way of adding a personalised touch to power point presentations is to record your voice over your lesson. The Social Subjects Faculty have been doing this by selecting Slide Show > Record from Current Slide. This will also allow you to highlight what part of the slide you are making a reference too.

The Explain Everything App is another way to record your voice while highlighting what you want pupils to look at. There is also a function to write and the pupils can see what you are writing. Here are examples of use from Maths, English and Modern Languages.
