We recognise the challenging circumstances in which we all find ourselves in will at times cause stress and anxiety for pupils and parents/carers.

The priority during this time is the health and wellbeing of pupils and their families and completion of schoolwork should not cause additional worries for our school community.

Pupils should try their best and if possible complete and submit work, however this should be for a **maximum time limit of 3 to 4 hours per day**. There is no expectation for pupils to complete all tasks assigned. The home learning activities are there to help and support you during the school closure.

### How will Pupil work be issued?

All pupil work will be issued via Show My Homework. Pupils can access this by logging in to their GLOW account and adding the Show My Homework tile to their Launch Pad or by downloading the app to their tablet or smartphone

### How should work be submitted?

The majority of work should be submitted on Show My Homework. Some teachers may request submission on Teams, this will be made clear on the task instruction.

### Accessing Microsoft Office

Every pupil can access Word, Power Point and Excel on all mobile phones, laptops, tablets by logging into Glow and installing it.

### Contacting Teachers
